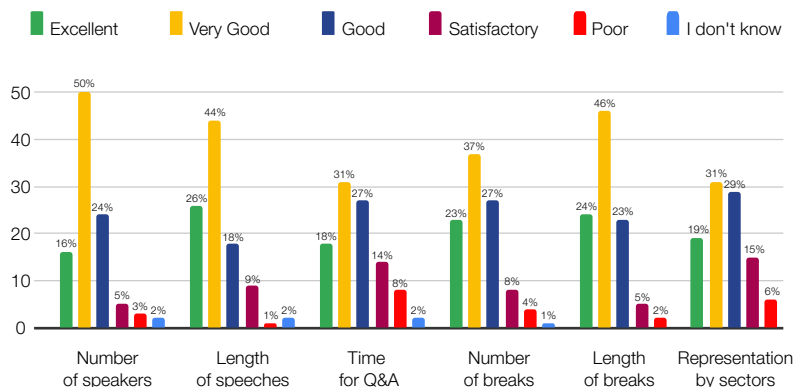
AlgaEurope is a great occasion to bring people from all areas of the topic together!
