



POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

To prepare your poster for AlgaEurope 2025, please read and follow the poster presentation guidelines below:

Poster Presentation Guidelines:

- Poster size must not exceed **100 cm wide x 200 cm high**. The optimal poster format is **A1 vertical**.
- Presenting authors must **print their physical poster** and **bring the poster** to the conference **by themselves**. The organizers of AlgaEurope 2025 **DO NOT** print posters on behalf of presenters.
- If your poster should be included in the AlgaEurope 2025 app, please **send your poster as a PDF by 1 December 2025** via [wetransfer](https://www.wetransfer.com) to k.kreuser@dlg.org.
- Place the **title of your paper** prominently at the top of the poster board to allow viewers to identify your paper easily. The title of your poster must be the same as the title you submitted. Don't forget to indicate the **author(s) name(s)** of your paper and **contact information**.
- Authors are encouraged to **include a photo of themselves** on the poster so that they can be identified.

Information for Setting up and Dismantling:

- We will **allocate you to a specific poster board**. Please check on-site which poster board you were assigned to, so you know where to set up your poster. You can set up your poster during the pre-registration on 8th December or in the morning of 9th December, the first conference day.
- You need to **take your poster** with you after **the end of the conference on Friday, 12th December**. If you do not take down your poster until 15:00 on 12th December, the poster will be disposed of.

Poster Presentation Award:

- Every presenting author of a poster will be considered for the Poster Presentation Award.
