The Presidents participated in the VII Seminar on Science and Technology in Biomodels at FIOCRUZ, where they presented the work of their associations. During the events, the group elaborated the strategic plan of FESSACAL and discussed the perspectives of laboratory animal science in the countries of South America. It was an excellent opportunity for the FESSACAL board to start building a new path for the Federation.

Specific use of ICLAS funds: The support of ICLAS made it possible to cover the accommodation expenses of the presidents of the FESSACAL member societies, leaving other expenses such as air tickets, accommodation expenses and others on account of the financial support obtained through collaborating companies.
