ICLAS VETERINARY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The ICLAS Veterinary Scholarship Program announces a call for applicants, with a due date of August 1, 2023.

For many veterinarians, the time and financial and personal cost of leaving employment and family to attend an established training program in a distant area is too big an obstacle to overcome. One option that can minimize these concerns is a program of modular, on-line classes combined with short periods of practical training in accredited programs.

There are several such programs in Europe and North America. These programs are recognized by groups such as **FELASA, CALAM, and ECLAM**, and provide official certificates of training, or an academic degree, upon completion.

The scholarship award is for 2/3 the total costs, up to maximum of €7,000. The student or his/her employer should fund the remaining 1/3 of the costs, paying for the initial training module, to demonstrate commitment to completing the program, as well as the ability to meet the academic and language requirements.
