Dear Colleagues,

Thank you for your interest in the 'ICLAS Scholarship Program for Veterinarians in Laboratory Animal Science and Medicine'.

Please note that applications for an ICLAS scholarship will only be considered if they meet the following criteria:

Qualifications: applicants must have a recognised degree in Veterinary Science that allows practice as a veterinarian in the respective countries.

Residence: applicants must live in an area without access to training in the region and also lack the necessary funds for tuition and travel.

Scholarship: this scholarship will provide up to two-thirds of the costs or up to a maximum of 7,000 Euros per applicant, whichever is less. The applicant and/or the applicant's employer must pay the remaining of the expenses.

Costs: the costs covered include tuition, as well as travel, housing and daily expenses while attending one of the designated programs.

Payments: the scholarship is paid directly to the administration of the training programs, and no funds are given directly to student applicant.

Programs: the applicant must have already applied to and been already accepted in one of the designated programs listed in the application form below. ICLAS will ask for confirmation that the applicant has been provisionally accepted into the program as stated in the application.

Selection process: The application will be reviewed by the ICLAS Education Committee, following established evaluation criteria.

Results: Applicants will be informed of the outcome within 30 days after last date to receive the applications.

Letters of recommendation: applicants must send two letters of recommendation written in English with their application. One of the letters must be from the applicant's employer recommending the applicant and agreeing to allow the applicant the time away from work to complete the coursework and/or attend the practical sessions including travel, within the program's specified time period. **Letter from the course Organiser/s will not be considered as a second recommendation letter**.
