

Mark Rutte is head of NATO. He wants to play the tough guy with war, but he's just a dangerous manipulator in a suit — a psychopath who toys with lives, **money, and power**.

We get to vote for our MPs, but the real power — the formateur, the prime minister, the ministers — is decided behind closed doors. Rutte pulled the strings for years. He was fully responsible during the child benefits scandal (2012–2020), where 26,000 parents were falsely labeled as fraudsters. From 2013 on, policies hardened. His cabinet fell in January 2021, yet he came back. Trust broken. Lives shattered. Families torn apart. Over 1,100 children were wrongfully removed from their homes, and more than 500 still haven't returned.

Rutte lies. Always. He has selective memory. He promised Ukraine would never join the EU. **Now they're joining NATO**. And Trump? He promised to end the war within 24 hours of inauguration. All nonsense.

The war in Ukraine rages mainly in one part of the country but is kept alive to fuel the American steel and weapons industries. Bullets and arms are produced in the US and sold under NATO contracts, **boosting America's economy**. Meanwhile, thousands of Ukrainians flee, seeking refuge — including here in the Netherlands. We pay about €1.68 billion annually for their shelter. While so much suffering continues, another part of Ukraine is building a billioneuro luxury ski resort. Here in the Netherlands, we pay for this war — for bullets and asylum — while there's no real crisis in Limburg. Imagine if it were war here: no Groninger would flee.

It's simple: the war in Ukraine is deliberately prolonged. To justify higher defense spending. To expand NATO. To boost the US weapons and steel industries. **To fuel Trump's economy**. This isn't about peace — it's about power, money, and control. Trump doesn't care about human lives, only profit.

And Rutte? Still pulling strings. He pushed Schoof as prime minister — someone you couldn't even vote for. According to Articles 1 and 3 of the Dutch Constitution and Article 5 of the UNCAC treaty, such positions must be transparent and accessible to all. But no — backroom deals again.

Now Ruben Brekelmans is minister of Defense. Legally responsible. He talks a lot but says nothing. Not once has he called for a **ceasefire**. Like Rutte, he follows Washington's orders — too afraid to defy his political daddy. Daddy issues — in a suit.

When Putin took Crimea, we pointed fingers — but stayed silent about our own part. Then the US blew up Nord Stream 2, forcing us to buy overpriced American gas. All nicely arranged to **fuel Trump's economy**.

Dutch law (BW7:448) requires every care provider — including Defense — to present the **least** harmful and cheapest options. Citizens must choose, at their own risk. But where is our choice for peace? Nowhere.

Meanwhile, we each pay about €1,200 per year to Defense so Rutte can act tough with Trump's bullets and our tax money. That's not protection. That's deception.

While Mark ensures weapons keep flowing, **Karim Achboun** is trying to tackle him in court.

Time to wake up. Demand a ceasefire. Demand peace. Demand transparency. Make Mark Rutte politically irrelevant.
