



01. ABOUT MAXIME

Maxime's racing journey began when his dad received a racing license course for his birthday, sparking a passion that ran through the family. Starting in karting, Maxime quickly progressed to cars, making his debut in the Dutch Supercar Challenge in 2019.

In 2020, Maxime finished 3rd overall in the MX-5 Cup and made impressive guest appearances in the Porsche Supercup and Lamborghini Super Trofeo. The following year, he and Teekens took on a full season in the Super Trofeo, claiming five podiums, while Maxime also impressed in the BMW M2 Cup, earning multiple podiums across Dutch and German series.

His breakthrough came in 2022, winning both the German and Benelux BMW M2 Cups with 8 and 11 wins, respectively. This led to a WEC Rookie Test in Bahrain, where he topped the Porsche GTE RSR timesheets.

In 2023, Maxime joined Project 1 in the ADAC GT4, showing strong pace despite BMW's struggles. A call-up from FK Performance for an ADAC GT Masters debut at the Red Bull Ring saw him deliver a race win and fastest lap, proving his talent once again.

In 2024, Maxime stepped up to a full-time drive in the ADAC GT Masters with a BMW M4 GT3. It proved to be a successful season, securing two wins, a pole position, and six podiums. He remained in the title fight until the final race, ultimately finishing as Vice-Champion. His strong performances caught the attention of the renowned ROWE Racing BMW factory team, earning him a call-up to race in the GT World Challenge Europe at Monza.

Alongside his ADAC GT Masters campaign, Maxime also competed in the GT World Challenge Asia, using the series as preparation and collecting four podiums. The highlight of his season came with a standout victory at the Nürburgring 24 Hours, claiming the SP10 class win.

2025 saw Maxime returning to the GTWC Asia series to claim the title in the Silver Class. In Europe he lined up in the GT World Challenge Europe Sprint Cup with Paradine Competition, finishing on the podium 4 times and 4th in the Silver Class standings.
