

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

To prepare your poster for Seagriculture Asia-Pacific 2025, please read and follow the poster presentation guidelines below:

Poster Presentation Guidelines:

- Poster boards are 6x4 foot.
- Presenting authors must **print their physical poster** and **bring the poster** to the conference **by themselves**. The organizers **DO NOT** print posters on behalf of presenters.
- Place the title of your paper prominently at the top of the poster board to allow viewers to
 identify your paper easily. The title of your poster must be the same as the title you
 submitted. Don't forget to Indicate the author(s) name(s) of your paper and contact
 information.
- Authors are encouraged to include a photo of themselves on the poster so that they can be identified.

Information for Setting up, Dismantling and Presentation of the Poster:

- We will **allocate you to a specific poster board**. Please check on-site which poster board you were assigned to, so you know where to set up your poster.
- You need to **take your poster** with you at the end of the conference **on Thursday, 20 March**. If you do not take down your poster, the poster will be disposed.
- Please note that there will be no dedicated poster session. Delegates will mainly read the
 posters during break periods, and you may want to be present and available for discussion
 for some of the breaks.
