




How would you rate the organisation of the conference?




Seagriculture EU brings together seaweed professionals to exchange knowledge and foster partnerships to collectively advance the seaweed industry and unlock its full potential.



Seagriculture EU 2023 was marked with a record attendance of 221 delegates.





How would you rate the quality of the structure and format of the sessions?





