



Terms & Conditions

- 1] In case of exhibitor cancels his statement of attendance at least 30 days before the beginning of the convention, a percentage of the costs will be restituted. In case of cancelation in a shorter notice the full amount payable is due.
- 2] Any deposits made by stand holders are non-refundable
- 3] Each Single Booth occupies a surface of 3.50 x 2.00 metres and the organizer will provide: 2 tables, 2 chairs. Each Triple Booth occupies a surface of 7.00 x 2.00 metres and the organizer will provide: 4 tables, 4 chairs.
- 4] There are no sterilisation facilities so come prepared. One time use equipment only, you will be provided with a sharps container for needle disposal.
- 5] Photocopy and stencil equipment is provided by the organizer.
- 6] Each booth is available to the exhibitor from 16:00pm on Friday 25/10 or Saturday at 08:00am. Breakfast and coffee will be provided.
- 7] It is prohibited to apply piercings before the consent of the organiser.
- 8] The booths will be secured during the night and all the off hours of the event
- 9] Organizers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to stand holders equipment, stock, stand, persons, vehicles or any other damage. Entry to the event is at the stand holder's own risk. Refund will not be given in any circumstances except stated in line 1 of this document. The organiser strongly recommends stand holders to acquire the appropriate insurances.
- 10] During opening hours the stand holder is responsible for the security and goods at their booth
- 11] The organiser warrants to attract members of the general public to the event but accepts no responsibility whatsoever for final numbers of visitors on the event. Stand holder should always be prepared to plan in own clients if possible.
- 12] The stand holder can advertise his work and goods with printed material exclusively in the space of the booth and not in any other location, near the entrance or the parking area.
- 13] The minimum age for tattoos is 18 years. Under NO circumstances should a minor be tattooed (not even with parental consent)
